# Marrickville Metro, Marrickville NSW

Marrickville in Sydney's inner West is renowned for its industrial history and is home to a number of Victorian warehouses with a distinctive character that defines the area. Marrickville Metro is developing an existing industrial warehouse into a shopping centre housing 44 new retailers, including a number of indoor and alfresco dining options. The centre will retain much of the existing façade to celebrate the culture and history of Sydney's inner West.

### **Project Design Brief**

Each food preparation facility in the development requires a grease trap to treat tradewaste. With eight grease traps required to service the numerous restaurants, the excavation footprint was of concern to designers as available space was limited.

## **ACO's Solution**

ACO Passavant Lipumax-G 5000L grease trap

### Benefits

- The cylindrical design of Lipumax-G meant the excavation required a smaller footprint than a rectangular trap
- A single point of access to the grease trap makes maintenance quicker and easier
- The trap is manufactured from durable glass reinforced plastic, which provides excellent corrosion resistance to tradewaste
